**605.00 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION INCENTIVES CONTRACTS**

Upon receipt of a written request from a private non-sectarian school to provide services to eligible students under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 126.23, the Superintendent will appoint a team to:

1. Review the quality of the programs of the applicant school;
2. Review the status of the applicant school as a private non-sectarian school; and
3. Determine whether placement of Saint Paul students at the applicant school would be in conformance with the District's approved desegregation plan.

Following this review, the team will report its findings and recommendations to the Superintendent. The Superintendent may recommend to the Board that the District enter into a contract with the applicant school for placement of Saint Paul students.

The District will place students in private non-sectarian schools with which it contracts on a case-by-base basis.

No student will be placed by the District in such a school without the prior written consent of the parent or guardian.
